

These mini-grants offer eligible entities grant funding to recruit and engage volunteers in meaningful service activities or deliver a service-learning activity related to Dr. King. A service-learning activity is a teaching and learning strategy that integrates meaningful community service with instruction and reflection to enrich the learning experience, teach civic responsibility, and strengthen communities. Preference will be given to applicants who engage one other community partner in the event's planning, collaboration, or execution.

AmeriCorps Kansas has two applications available for the 2025 - 2026 grant

period. Read the descriptions below to learn which grant opportunity is right for your organization. Click on the link to access the application materials:

- AmeriCorps Kansas Operational Grant: This grant is for organizations interested in operating an AmeriCorps program in Kansas. This grant DOES require matching funds. Applicants must request a minimum of three Member Service Years (MSY). Due date: December 13, 2024 for staff review OR January 31, 2025 for Final Applications
- AmeriCorps Kansas Planning Grant: This grant is for organizations interested in a 12-month planning period to develop an operational AmeriCorps program in Kansas. This grant DOES require matching funds. Due date: January 31, 2025.


